Who is HealthNet TPO?

HealthNet TPO is an international NGO with roots in The Netherlands. Our mission is to support communities and help them to regain control and maintain their health and wellbeing. At the same time, we strengthen national healthcare systems to ensure health needs are met.

We do things a little differently here, we don't do aid. Instead, we connect with people and provide them with the tools to improve their own situations. We believe that even the most vulnerable people have the inner strength to (re)build a better future for themselves.

We currently operate in Afghanistan, Burundi, Colombia and South Sudan. Our head office in Amsterdam is responsible for the overall management of the organisation.

What is your role?

As a visual design intern, you will work closely with the Communications Officers to support HealthNet TPO's branding and visual communication efforts. Your creative work will help communicate our impact and connect with our audience.

Your responsibilities:

- Create visual elements aligned with HealthNet TPO's branding, such as social media templates, newsletter templates, slideshows, iconography, and more.
- Develop infographics and visual reports to communicate complex information clearly and effectively.
- Collaborate with colleagues across the organisation to produce visual content for various campaigns and projects.
- Assist in designing promotional materials, including brochures, posters, and banners.
- Support the creation of visual content for our website and ensure consistency with our brand guidelines.
- Contribute to the growth of our Instagram account, through engaging designs and content ideas.



• Participate in brainstorming sessions and contribute creative ideas to enhance our communication strategies.

Who are you?

- A student in graphic design, visual communication, or a related field. (Please note that due to Dutch legislation, we can only offer this internship to a student living and studying in the Netherlands).
- Fluent in English (Dutch is an advantage), with excellent communication skills.
- Proficient in Adobe Creative Suite (Photoshop, Illustrator, InDesign) and other design software.
- You have a strong portfolio showcasing your design skills and creativity.
- Detail-oriented with a keen eye for aesthetics and visual details.
- Able to work independently and within a small team, taking initiative to follow your own work schedule.
- Motivated to develop your skills and contribute to our mission of supporting communities affected by conflict and disaster.

What do we offer?

- Experience working for a large multi-programme international organisation.
